For those who did not purchase an Artist Kit, you will need to source the following list of materials:

- HB Pencil
- Eraser
- Ruler
- Pencil Sharpener
- Putty Rubber
- Black Charcoal Pencil
- White Charcoal Pencil
- Acrylic Paints
 - My selection includes: Titanium White, Primary Yellow, Yellow Ochre, Cadmium Red, Prussian Blue, Burnt Umber & Black.
- Tear Off Paint Palette,
- Pipette

Paint Brushes

- Golden or White Synthetic Round Tips, Size 2, 4, 6, & 12.
- Golden Synthetic Flathead, Size 8.
- Rigger Brush, Size 1 & 4.

To complete the tasks within class time I will be demonstrating using A3 canvas board. Most tasks will be possible to complete within the class time, although you may need some extra time at home to complete your artwork.

Some students prefer to work in sketchbooks to follow the demonstration & write notes, then using the skills demonstrated & the guides to create a 'best piece' after class.

Please access the course whichever way best suits you. The paper I will be using for the course is:

- A3 Canvas Board or Stretched Canvas.

- A4 Multimedia Sketchbook for designs, colour mixing, ideas and working in rough.
