Week 1 03/06 JUNE	Pen & Wash, Illustrative Tree We begin the course with a look at mark making and sketching. Using both Fineliner Pen & Watercolour Wash, we will explore how to create detail and drop in colour values.	
Week 2 10/13 JUNE	Watercolour Paint, Sunset Foliage We continue our exploration with watercolour to create a sunset landscape with foliage. You will learn how to layer washes to create depth and texture. Use your own photography or use our differentiated resources.	A A A A A A A A A A A A A A A A A A A
Week 3 17/20 JUNE	Mixed Media, Turner in Venice. This week we delve into the works of Turner in Venice. Learn how to use mixed media to create this interior scene using watercolour, gouache & white charcoal on brown watercolour paper.	
Week 4 24/27 JUNE	Watercolour & Gouache Paint, Stormy Sea. This week we build on your use of Watercolour & Gouache to create this stormy seascape. Use your own photography or our differentiated resources to create this atmospheric painting.	
Week 5 01/04 JULY	Acrylic Paint, Contemporary Landscape, Part 1. Inspired by Eleanor Spalding (showcased across), we begin your contemporary landscape. This week, you will plot out your composition, learn how to abstract details and pick a colour palette to work with. Use your own photography or our differentiated resources.	
Week 6 08/11 JULY	Acrylic Paint, Contemporary Landscape, Part 2. We finish The Landscape Course by completing your contemporary landscape painting. Experiment with brushstrokes & contrasting colour accents to create a colourful landscape.
