Shopping List

- HB Pencil
- Eraser
- Ruler
- Pencil Sharpener
- 0.1mm & 0.5mm Permanent Black Fineliner Pen (UniPin is an excellent brand).
- White Charcoal Pencil,
- White Gouache Paint
- Paint Palette,
- Palette Knife (My preference is the smaller diamond T15 Shape, but please purchase any size you wish to use),
- Pipette
- Watercolour Paints - preferably the Watercolour Paint tubes, rather than a tin however there is no difference in quality, just consistency.
 - My selection includes: White, Lemon Yellow, Yellow Ochre, Vermilion, Crimson Red, Grass Green, Green Deep, Prussian Blue, Ultramarine Blue, Burnt Sienna, Burnt Umber & Black.
- Acrylic Paints (Must include: primary red, primary yellow, ultramarine blue, black, burnt umber and white).
 - My selection includes: Black, Titanium White, Primary Yellow, Lemon Yellow, Crimson, Cadmium Red, Cadmium Green, Ultramarine Blue, Primary Blue & Burnt Umber.

Paint Brushes

- Golden or White Synthetic Round Tips, Size 2, 4, 6, & 12.
- Golden Synthetic Flathead, Size 8 & 18.
- Mop Brush, Size ½"
- Rigger Brush.

Paper

To complete the tasks within class time I will be demonstrating using A4 paper. Most tasks will be possible to complete within the class time, although you may need some extra time at home to complete your artwork.

Some students prefer to work in sketchbooks to follow the demonstration & write notes, then using the skills demonstrated & the guides to create a 'best piece' on either A4 or A3 paper.

Please access the course whichever way best suits you. The paper I will be using for the course is:

- A4 White Watercolour Paper x 3
- A4 Brown Watercolour Paper x 1 (into Amazon, type: SMLT Authentic Line AA-35/B A4 Brown Watercolour Pad Authentic Pad 280gsm Brown Watercolour Paper 35 Sheets)
- A3 Acrylic Paint Paper or Canvas Board x 1
- A4 Multimedia Sketchbook for designs, ideas, or working in rough.

Optional Extras:

For those who have acquired the Artist Kit you will have the majority of all the materials needed to complete the course. There are a few more items you could purchase, which would be useful to have.

These are:

- Paper Towel (Kitchen Roll)
- Masking Tape or Frog Tape
- An A3+ or A2 Drawing Board or thick piece of cardboard to tape your work onto.
- A table top or standing easel to work on.
- Two Water Containers
